#### Lunch Time Meal Deals and Break Time Snacks

From 17 April 2023 the cost of snacks at break times will be increasing to 80p. The snacks have stayed at 60p since 2014 but we are no longer able to cover the cost of the food to produce them.

The price of the meal deal at lunch time remains at £2.80 and includes a meal, dessert and drink. We continue to provide the Free Munch Meals for families on Tuesdays 4.00-5.30pm and Thursdays 4.00-5.30pm for families and unaccompanied students.

- The Munch Pantry is open daily 11.00am-2.30pm where you can pay £5 and choose £15 worth of food.
- free emergency pre-packed meals should you need them at any time

- We can assist sometimes with other items when they become available.

# Some Reminders for next term

Mobile phones and air pods are not permitted in school. In all circumstances these will be taken to reception until the end of the day if they are seen and a community duty will be set.
