Daily reminders

Every evening and every morning, parents will receive a reminder text about the exams for the following days. We hope this is a helpful prompt for everyone.

Breakfast briefings for exams 8.00am every day

Every day throughout the exam season, subject teachers and tutors will be in the school restaurant from 8.00am to support with final exam preparation. Breakfast is free as always and students are encouraged to come in early, eat, take time to calm any nerves and ask any final questions of staff.

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Exam masterclasses every day after school

From Monday, period 6s are replaced with daily exam masterclasses. Immediately after school each day, teachers overseeing the following day's exams will lead a 30 minute masterclass supporting students with final preparations and reminding them of key approaches. All are encouraged to attend.
