

## Park's Book Week 2022

28<sup>th</sup> Feb – 4<sup>th</sup> March (World Book Day 3rd March)

### Summary

Park's Book Week will see everyone at Park Community School continue their celebration of reading and additional opportunities for the development of cultural capital and exploring diversity. This academic year has seen a further shift in the reading culture and a greater focus on reading for pleasure and exploration of texts through Park's Reading Canon, tutor reading and English lessons. Park's Book Week 2022 will be an opportunity to build upon this further and celebrate all things book and reading related!

### Initiatives and Competitions

1. **A Free book from Park's canon for all students:** All students will have the opportunity to receive a free book from the Canon. In the first week back, students will complete a reading survey in English lessons and select their free book upon completion. Books and presentation stickers to be given out to students during tutor time.
2. **Match the book review :** Throughout the week, match the teacher to the review and book front cover will played in tutor bases. 3 match ups per day will be provided by Ann-Marie and prizes for the first correct answers per house will be shared daily.
3. **Quote treasure hunt** – quotes from Canon novels will be hidden around the school. Students have to find the quotes and work out the novel it is from. Students then share this with AHu or a member of the English department to win a prize.
4. **Re-create a book cover competition.** The aim is to recreate a book cover. This could be via drawing, painting, outfit etc. Photos to be submitted with person holding said book cover up. Prizes for first, second and third place.
5. **The Big Reading Quiz.** Students complete the big reading quiz in tutor time. Questions will be linked to Canon books and other classics.
